

UPDATE FROM ALUMNI PRESIDENT University Establishing Accreditation Process for Live-In Status and Alcohol Policies

The University of Missouri is in the process of establishing accreditation protocols in the areas of alcohol use and freshman living requirements. While details are still evolving, the concept is to rank each chapter according to its performance in academics, loss prevention, organizational oversight, and other critical areas of operations.

This fall, security audits were instituted on a once-per-month basis to ensure that risk management guidelines were being enforced. The results of these audits will be combined with the other accreditation factors to determine whether a chapter will be required to be totally alcohol-free for the upcoming year.

Similarly, accreditation criteria are being developed to determine if a chapter will be eligible to have freshman members live in the chapter house. It appears that the fall of 2014 would be the earliest implementation date for changes in this area. We will keep you advised as things develop in these areas.


Missouri Chapter Initiates 29 New Brothers


