## Demolition Prepares Missouri Chapter for Next Phase *Help Us Complete Construction on Time—Donate Today!*

**T**hanks to our loyal and generous alumni, it has begun: demolition of our old house and construction of the new!

Today, we stand strong on the brink of a new era as we build a state-of-the-art home that will preserve the legacy of all past and present DUs and secure our future at the University of Missouri. On behalf of the campaign leadership, thank you to all alumni for your interest and participation in the campaign. It has been a very successful year for Missouri Chapter!

**Construction is underway with the hope to have the house move-in ready by fall 2015.** Its features include:

- Alumni room and lounge for gatherings
- Formal dining room and chapter room
- Spacious porch and patio
- Commercial and weekend kitchen
- Library and study areas
- Sleeping capacity of 78
- Underground parking garage with laundry, vending, and workshop for special projects

We have received \$2,588,927 in commitments from 262 donors to date, but we need everyone's

participation to secure the remaining \$411,073. I challenge us to not only reach this goal by fall 2015 when the active members move in, but to surpass our goal to lessen the burden on our present and future brothers. Every dollar raised is one less dollar members will have to repay after they move into the new house.

That is why I am asking those of you who have not contributed to please do so now. If you have already contributed and can dig a little deeper, please do so.

As I think about the future and the undergraduates moving into the new house next year, I envision everyone's name on the plaque that will be on display in the house. Take a look at the donor list.
